


Twisted Ring + S

Parting Arrow + Diamond


This shows two arrows parting ways, hidden in the shape of a diamond

This shows one arrow exiting the encompassing shape of a diamond.


Divorce does not need to seem like the end of the world; it can simply be a parting of ways for two different people's life paths... occasionally, it can be something that only one person is seeking.

The one arrow can emphasize the focus on the one client being who you advocate for and the continuous shape of the diamond can make the diamond shape easier to understand.






Scales of Justice + Zen

The addition of a person in a meditation position helps to bring a calming sense, where your services will ease your clients of any stress.




Chat Bubbles + letter S

This logo pushes the idea of you opening dialogs and being a mediator. This is something can can work for divorce, paternity rights, or pre-nups; all situations call for clear communications.






Wedding Ring + Chat Bubble

The tail of the chat bubble puts a metaphoric chip in the ring, the sign of unity.






Broken Heart + Warped Rings
